Timeline Associated With The Accreditation Process

7 months (Steps 1, 2, and 3)

- On average the institution may take a minimum of two (2) months to prepare the <u>Letter of Internet</u>, <u>Report of Eligibility</u>, <u>Ownership Disclosure Form</u>, and <u>other related documents</u> for submission to NAECOB.
- NAECOB will take an average of two (2) months to review submitted documents.
- NAECOB will take an average of two (2) months to plan, schedule and host Advisory Visit.
- NAECOB will take an average of one (1) month to communicate decision to institution: i.e.
 whether to begin the formal 'Application for Accreditation Candidacy' Process OR if the
 institution will need to make substantial changes before resubmitting a favorable application.

18 months (Steps 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14 & 15)

- NAECOB will take an average of two (2) months to deliver Self Study Report Workshops.
- Institutions will take on average two (2) months to submit updated 'Accreditation Readiness Reports at dates determined by NAECOB.
- NAECOB will take an average of two (2) months to complete <u>Candidate Progress Visits</u> at dates determined by NAECOB.
- Institution will take an average of six (6) months to submit Self-Study Report to NAECOB.
- NAECOB will take an average of three (3) months to plan, schedule and host Peer-Review Evaluators' On-Site Visit for Candidate Institution
- NAECOB will take an average of three (3) months to complete <u>On-Site Visitation Report</u> and communicate
 it to the Institution
- Institution will take an average of two (2) months to submit Formal Response to On-Site Visitation Report.
- NAECOB will take an average of one (1) month to communicate their decision on the application. That
 is, whether *Initial Accreditation Status* has been granted, denied, or deferred by NAECOB.

10 months (Steps 4, 5, 6, & 7)

- NAECOB will take an average of three (3) months to deliver Accreditation Candidacy Workshops.
- Institutions will take on average six (6) months to submit completed '<u>Application for Accreditation Candidacy</u>', <u>Accreditation Readiness Report</u>, and other relevant documents.
- NAECOB will take an average of one (1) month to communicate their decision on the application. That is, whether <u>Accreditation Candidacy Status</u> has been granted, denied, or deferred by NAECOB.

1 month (Step 16)

- NAECOB will take an average of one (1) month to deliver <u>Newly Accredited</u> Institution Workshops.
- Newly Accredited Institutions will be informed about the expectations, periodic evaluations, visitations, and reports that will be schedule on determined dates
- Each type of periodic review provides an opportunity for the institution to communicate and document ongoing developments in their institution in relation to accreditation standards.
